“ many ” と “ much ”

I have many books .

I have much water .

I have some books .

I have some water .

“ many ” は「たくさんの」という意味で、後ろには必ず「複数形」がくる。(数)
“ much ” も「たくさんの」という意味だが、後ろの名詞は「単数形」がくる。(量)
英語では「数えられるモノ(数)」と「数えられないモノ(量)」をはっきりと区別する。
“ some ” は『数』(可算名詞)でも『量』(不可算名詞)でも、どちらでも使うことができる。
