<未来形>の"be going to ~ "の「過去形?」

He was going to play tennis yesterday.

They were going to come to Kiryu.

She wasn't going to buy the book.

"be going to ~"には「過去形」があり、「~するつもりでした」「~する予定でした」という意味になる。一見すると不思議な表現だが、日本語にもある表現なので、慣れてしまえばそれまでである。
